

Dear Local Artists & Crafters:

We invite you to show and sell your handmade work at the Taste of Wheaton 2016 (June 3-5), a cooperative event of the Wheaton Park District and Wheaton Chamber of Commerce. Booth space will line the sidewalks of Hale Street & Karlskoga Avenue, an area between the carnival located in downtown Wheaton and entertainment in Memorial Park. Last year this fest attracted over 20,000 local and regional guests. This event features the Cosley Run for the Animals, a business expo, family entertainment, beer garden, food vendors, and more.

Attached to this letter you will find an application. Listed below are requirements and additional information about this fest.

- Applications will be juried. Please submit 3 photos (digital preferred) that best represent your items. Photos and checks of those not chosen to show will be returned by mail. Photos may be used for event advertising materials. Please provide a short biography to accompany your artwork in advertising materials. 2015 returning artists do not need to send photos.
- Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own canopies and displays, such as tables, hangers, boards, crates, sandbags, etc. Tables must be covered to the ground on all sides. Booth spaces are 10'x10'. Security will be present throughout the night. All booths must be disassembled and packed away by 8pm on Saturday.
- Exhibitors may set up and begin sales Friday evening, 4-8pm (pricing listed below). Friday sales are optional and exhibitors may pay the fee for the convenience of early load in. Exhibitors interested in exhibiting Saturday only, must set up early morning, between 5-6:30am. No exceptions are made as the Cosley Run for the Animals will prohibit street access from 6:30-9:00am. Indicate your preference on the application. Saturday set up times will be assigned on a first come, first served basis. Exhibitors must abide to the set up time noted on their confirmation sheet. All exhibitors must be unloaded by Saturday at 6:30am.
- Back by Popular Demand, Sunday Option: Exhibitors may opt to return for sales on Sunday. You may purchase a spot at in combination with your Fri/Sat fee, or you may choose the Sunday ONLY option. You will NOT be at your same location on Sunday, so you will need to close down Saturday evening, and re-load in on Sunday morning beginning at 8am. There will be no load in assistance on Sunday. There are a limited number of tents on Sunday, so they will be handed out on first come/first serve basis. Sunday sales hours will be from 12-6pm. Sunday will be located in Memorial Park, not on the street as the previous two days.
- Exhibitors must be 18 years or older and display for the duration of the show. Artists are to be set up and ready for business by 8:30am on Saturday.

- There is no rain site. Artists are encouraged to have suitable materials to protect work from inclement weather.
- All tents must be properly weighted down for the safety of patrons. The fest is not responsible for any lost or damaged items (including tents).
- Limited daytime parking is available for exhibitors in the City Hall parking lot (located at Wheaton Ave. and Karlskoga Ave.) or available in the downtown Wheaton parking garage (Wesley St. between Hale St. and Wheaton Ave.)
