Arrowhead has a restaurant and golf course with a clubhouse.



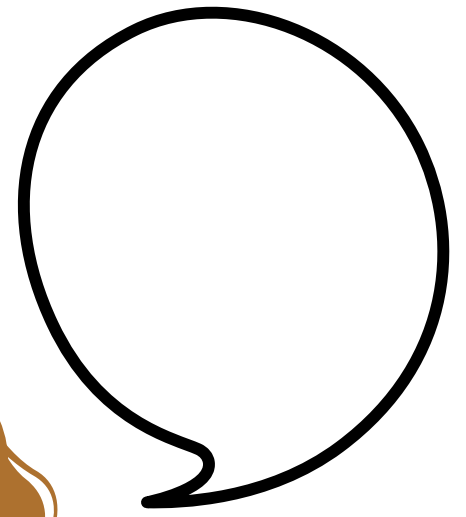
It's okay to feel excited, curious, or nervous about visiting Arrowhead. Everyone is there to have fun, relax, and enjoy the experience.



If I want to look at the menu before we go, I can find the menu online. There is also a children's menu!



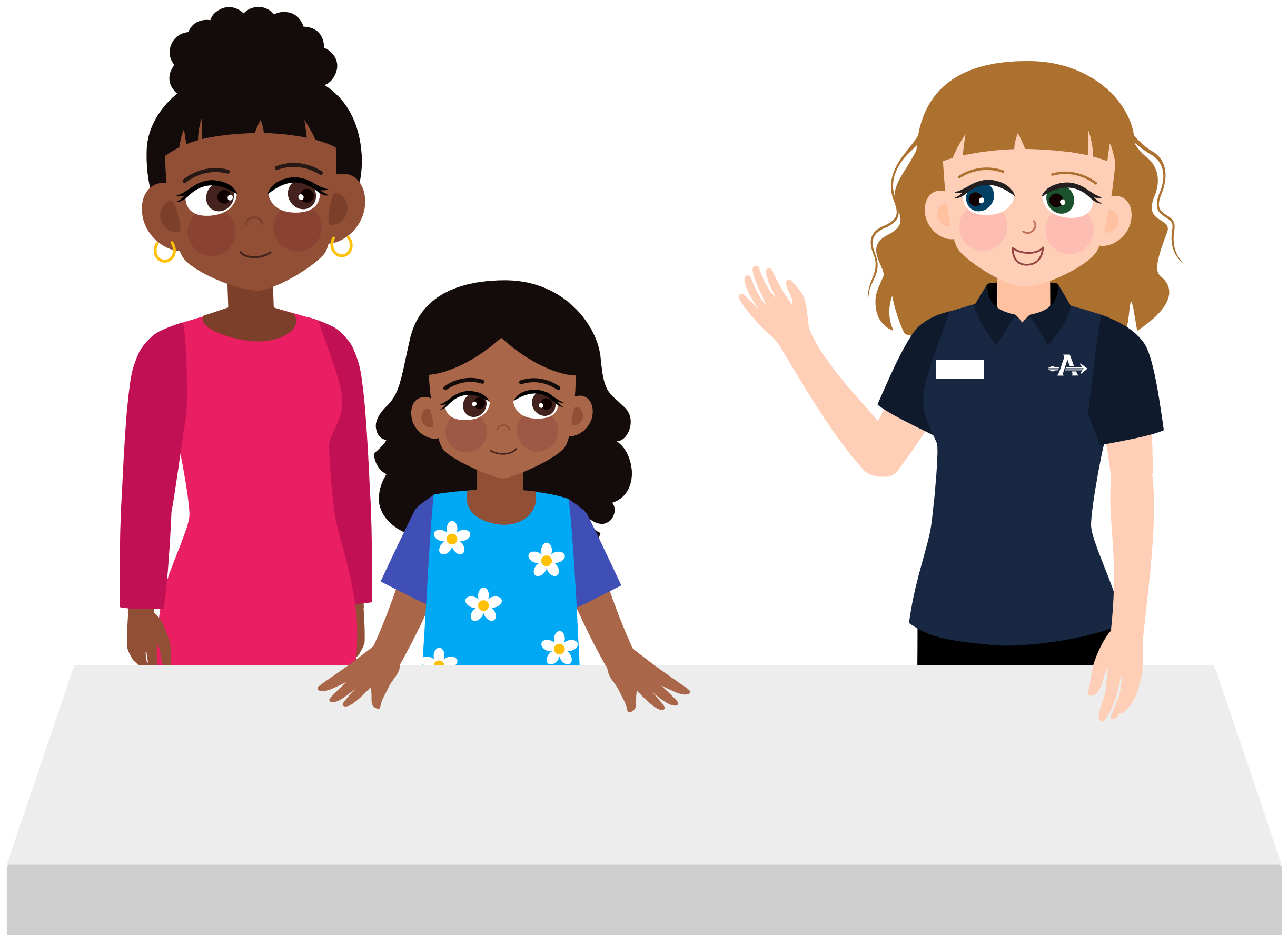
When we arrive, we will check in at the host stand and wait to be shown to our table.

If we are sitting outside or by a window, I may see a golf cart driving by!



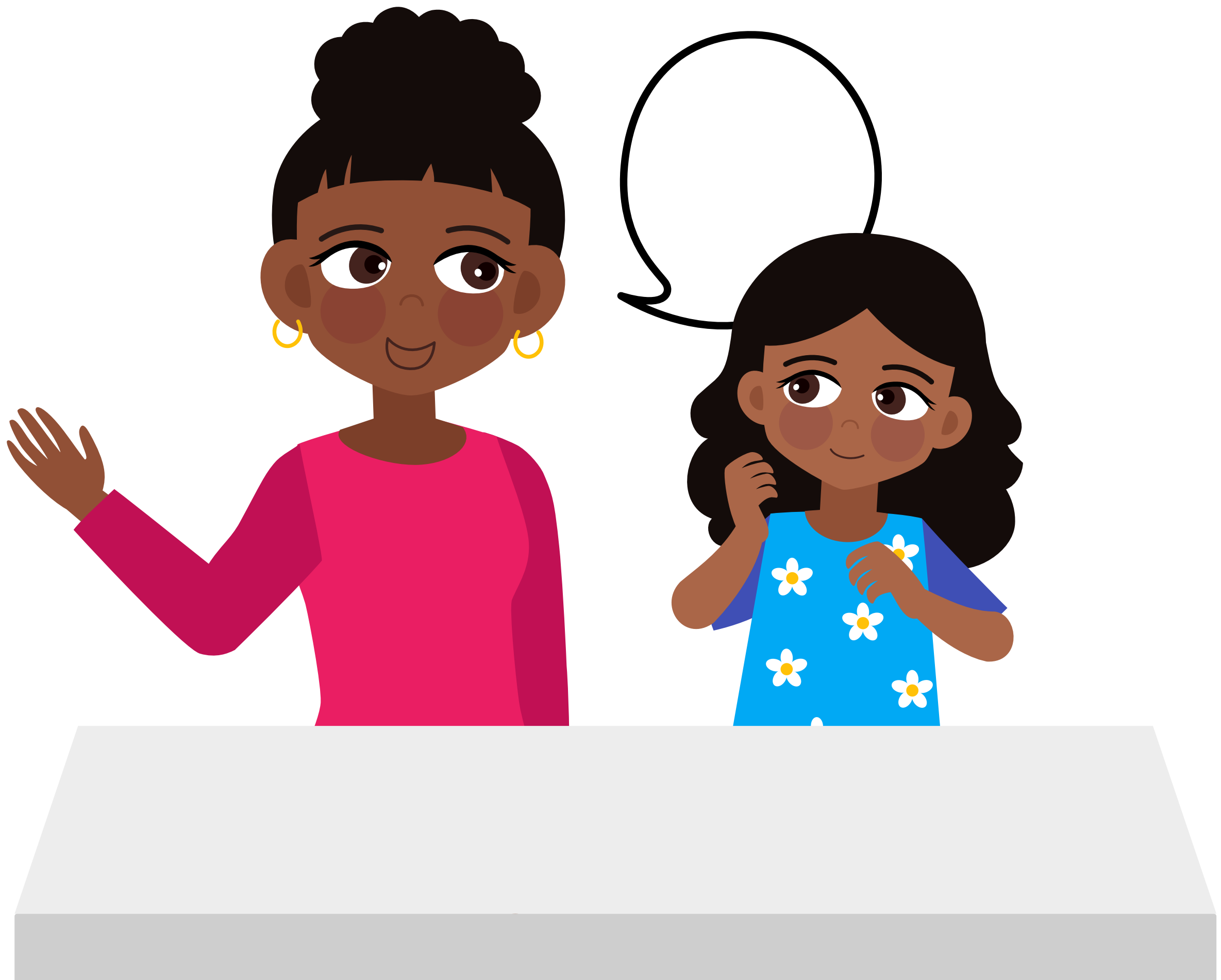
Once seated, we will meet our server. They will be taking care of us while we are visiting!



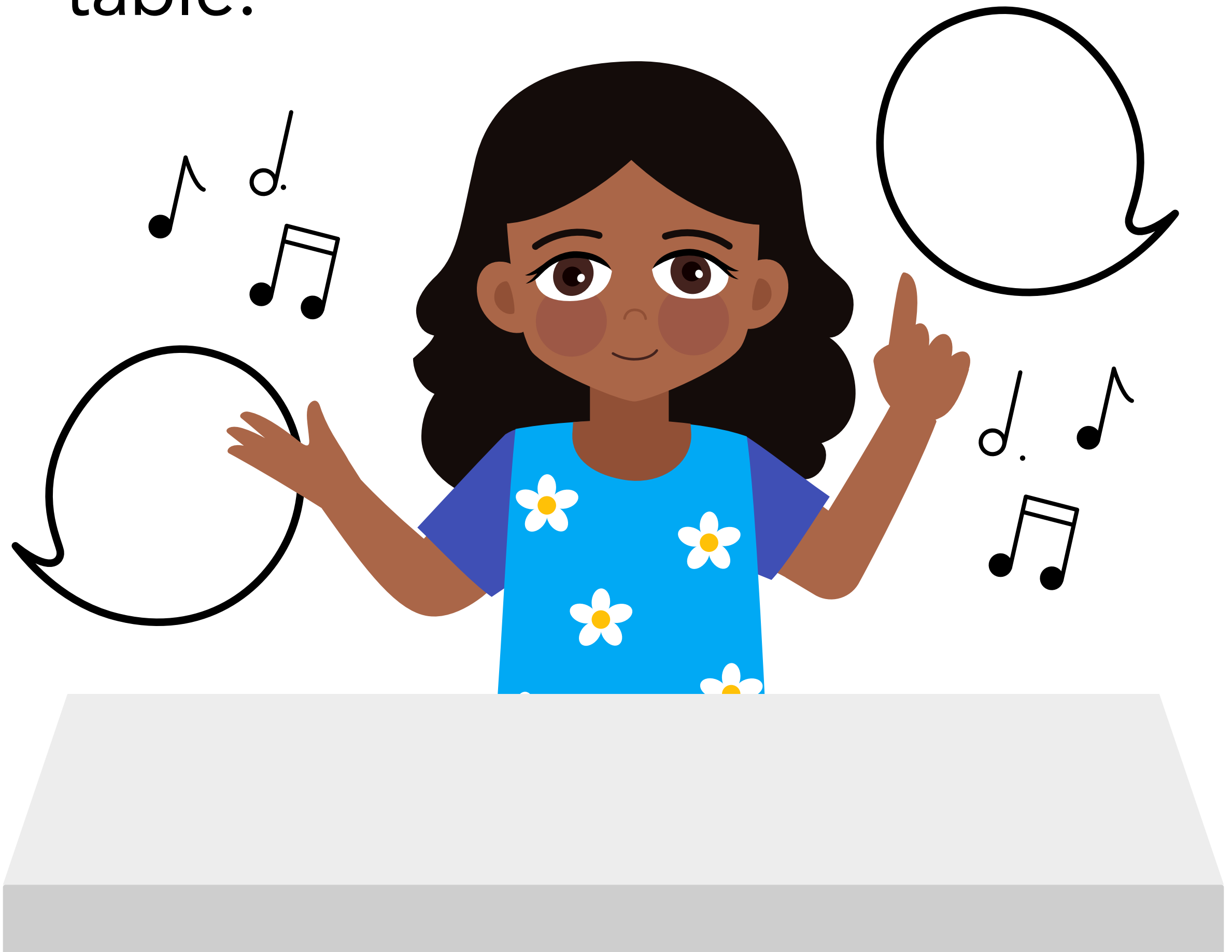
When we are ready, we will look at the menu and order food and drinks from our server.



We will need to be patient and wait for our drinks and food to arrive.



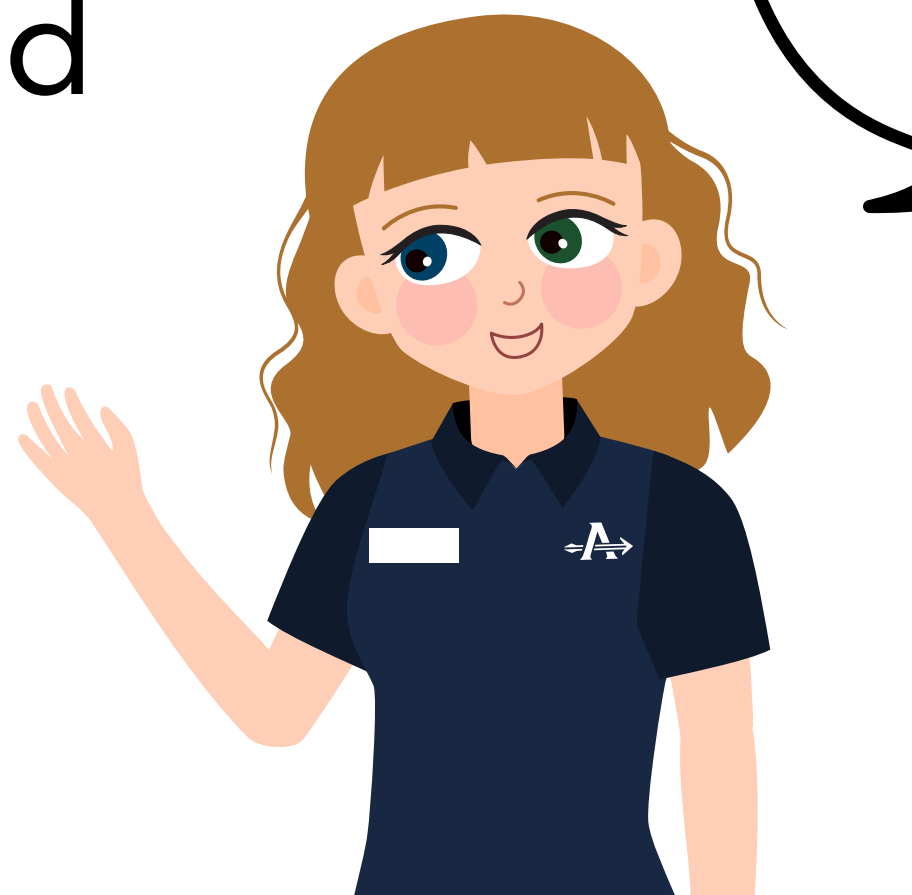
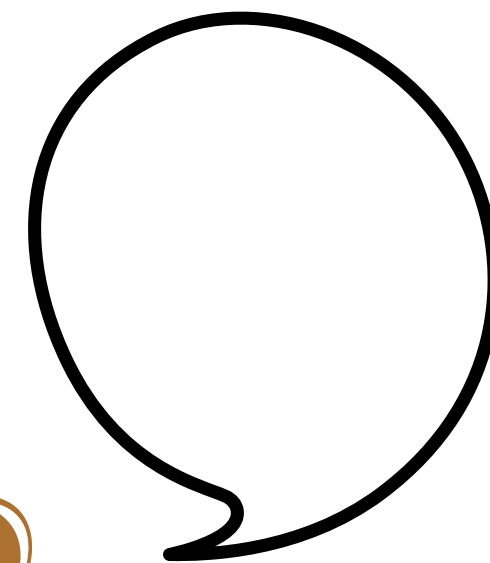
There may be sounds from tv screens, music playing, people talking or clinking dishes near our table.
