The current backstops at Briar Patch Park are over 30 years old and need to be replaced. Staff worked with the Athletic Department and Briarcliffe Youth Baseball & Softball to determine their needs for the replacement of two backstops at the Park. The new backstops will be taller and have higher dugout fences which will provide greater safety for the players and patrons at the park. The bids were solicited on December 5th and they were opened on December 19, 2019. The results were as follows:
