9. If the contract is broken within thirty (30) days of the said event, the employer will be charged the full amount contracted above. This contract can only be broken in writing and such correspondence must include any and all aforementioned service fees

10. The dates and/or hours of the above described engagement may be changed by the above named employer at a service fee of \$50.00 per modification. Modifications are subject to the contractor's approval and/or availability, must be initiated by both of the undersigned parties on the face of this document, and described in detail if necessary on the reverse of this document.
