Staff solicited bids for converting the two tennis courts at Central Park into six pickleball courts. Plans and specifications were sent out to the bidders on February 3, 2021 and the bids were opened on February 24, 2021. The results were as follows:

Bid results were reviewed and Chicagoland has successfully completed projects for the district in the past.

Opportunities to expand pickleball were discussed at the September 9, 2020 Buildings and Grounds subcommittee meeting and direction was given to pursue the courts at Central.

STAKEHOLDER PROCESS:
