The paver walkway at the entrance to Cosley Zoo and an area outside of the Kiebler Barn are in need of extensive repair due to separation and failing edge restraint. In 2015 and 2019, similar work was done near the gift shop building with a limited budget. This work will complete the repairs of the driveway from the parking lot to west end of the Visitor's Center.

Additionally, the existing driveway is wider than necessary and will be narrowed by about three feet. This will reduce the cost of the project and make planned future fence work easier and less expensive. Unit pricing is included in the bid to add the possibility of increasing the area that can be repaired within budget.

Staff solicited bids on February 19 and the results are as follows:

Unfortunately, only one bid was received and it was much higher relative to last year's work completed for \$11 per sq. ft.
