Once backstage, I will find the chair with my name on it.



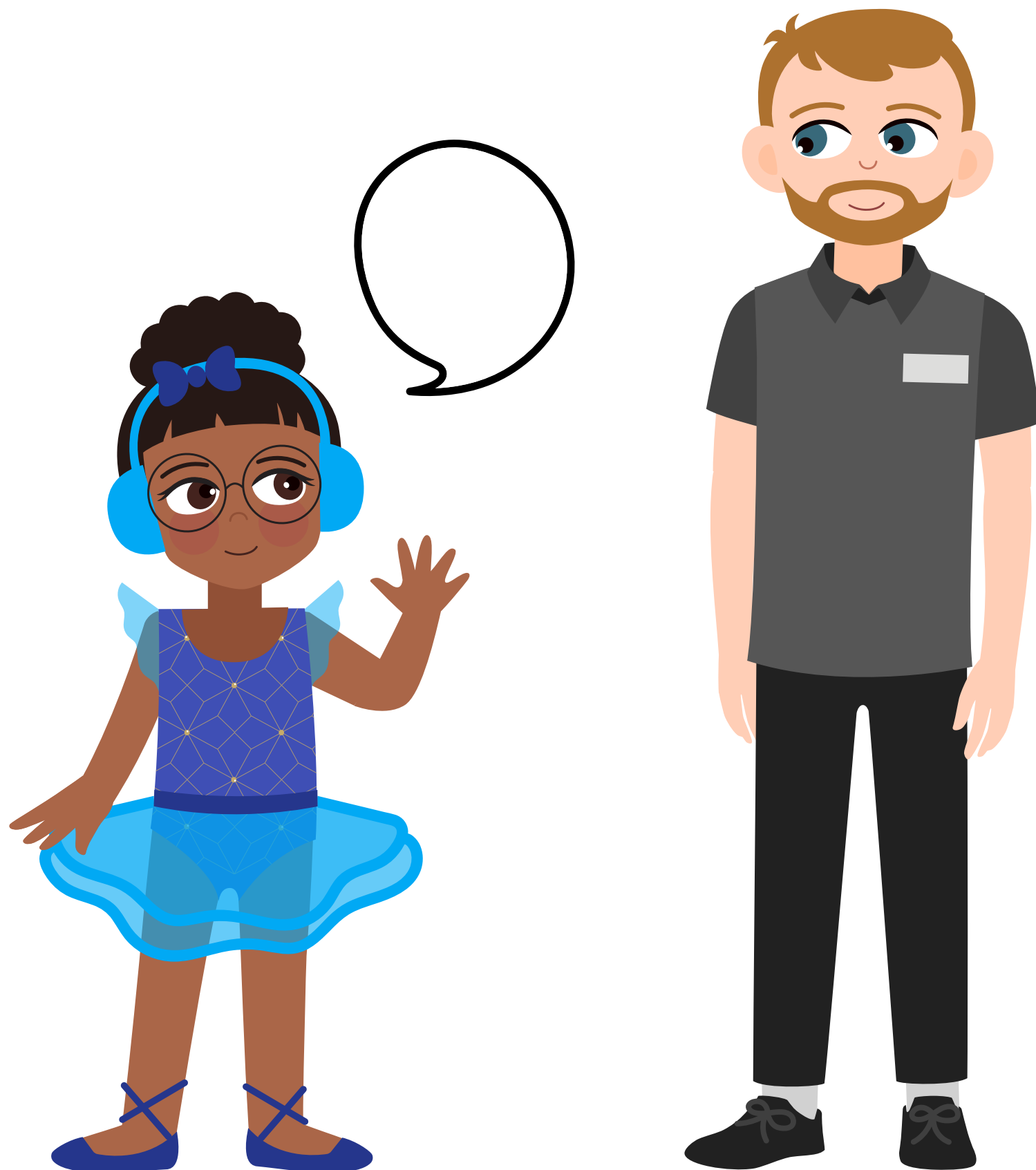
I will wait with my dance friends

When it is my turn to perform, I will line up with my dance class and follow our backstage helper to the stage.



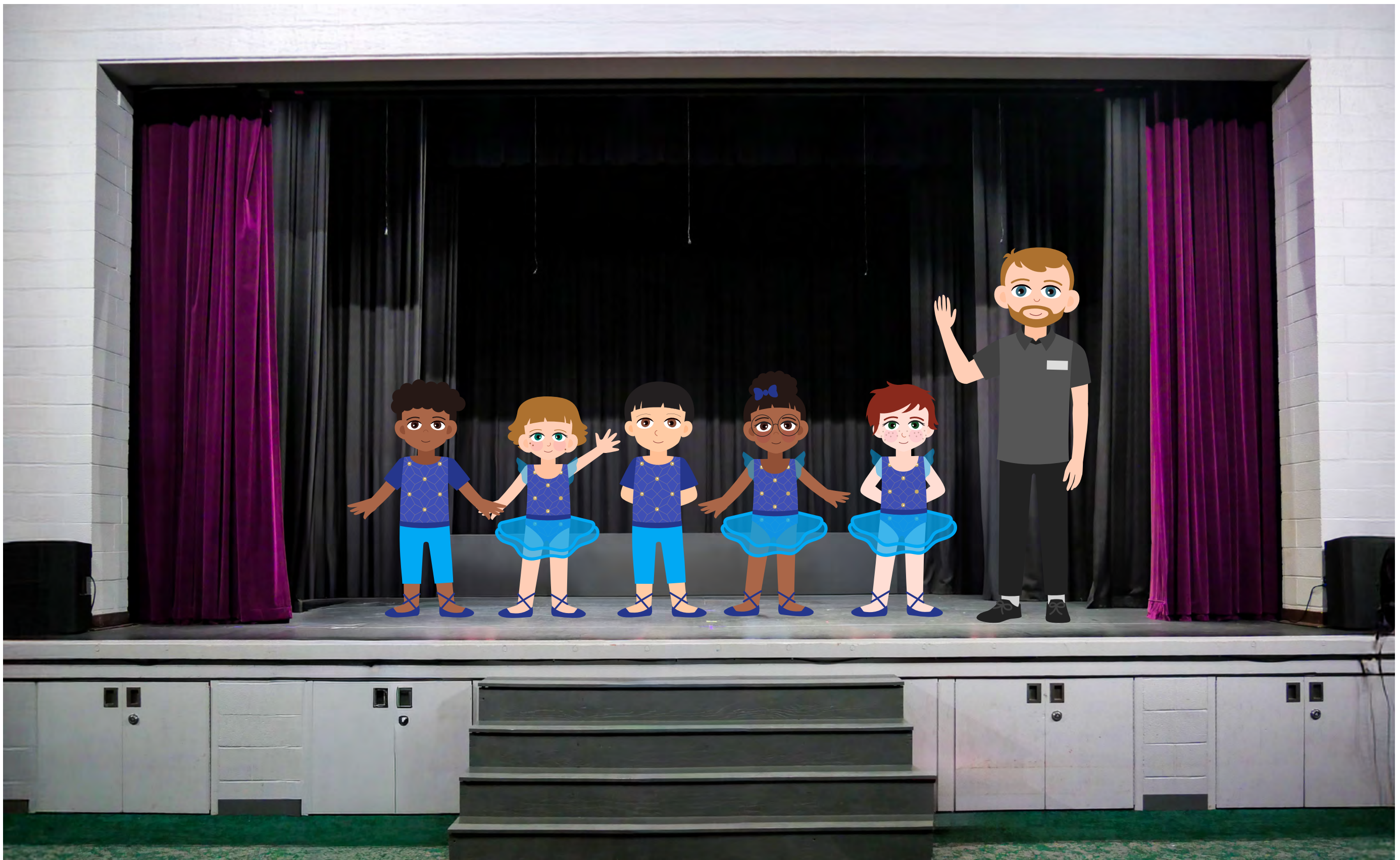
I will get to perform on stage with my dance class in front of our families and friends.
