AGREEMENT FOR USE OF FAIRGROUNDS FACILITIES

Made this 3rd day of November, 2020 by and between the DuPage County Fair Association of Wheaton, Illinois, party of the first part and Wheaton Partk District party of the second part,

Witnessed: In consideration, the named parties agree as follows: The party of the first part agrees to furnish the use of the

For the Period of Saturdays & Sundays from January 2 - March 14, 2021 - For Indoor baseball & softball practice - EXCLUDING HITTING: 10:00am - 7.00pm

Under the following conditions: The building will be left in the same order as was received. All tennis nets will be reset and in usable order. Park District Staff will be present during use and all COVID Protocols of the State of Illinois will be followed.

- The party of the second part agrees to pay the party of the first part a service charge of \$3000.00_ for the use of Fairgrounds facilities. This amount to be completely paid one month in advance of the date of occupancy. Signed contract to be returned within 30 days with deposit.
- 2. All organizations using Fairgrounds facilities shall arrange their own set up. Fairgrounds custodian to be available to locate equipment needed provided this equipment is owned by the Fair Association and is available for use. Do not block any exits. The DuPage County Fair Association reserves the right for show set up to occur on morning of event. DCFA will work with Promoter to allow access to Building(s) for Set Up dependent on other uses.
- Following each event, damages or losses to be reported to organization as soon as possible with party of the second part being responsible for the return of lost items and the repair of damaged equipment.
- Service charges for the use of Fairgrounds facilities to vary depending on the amount of heat needed, amount of electrical use, amo discardable material to be hauled away and the amount of time required for the Fairgrounds custodians to dismantle and cleanup foll wi event. Party of second part is responsible for clean-up - including emptying garbage cans and placing garbage in dumpsters found ou de
- Any group using Fairgrounds facilities where food is to be served to the general public shall clear with the DuPage County He th Department. All Bottled/Packaged soda, water, etc. sold by vendors shall be Dr. Pepper/7-Up, Snapple Brands. The American Bottling Company is our Fairgrounds Sponsor. Vendors can contact Fair Office for product list and availability. Any food products or garbage shall be disposed of upon completion of meal and not left for cleanup by custodians. Disposal containers are on hand for this purpose outside buildings.
- 6. The party of the second part shall maintain in force General Liability and Property Damage insurance in the amount of \$2,000 The party of the second part shall maintain in force General Lindburg and Property Damage insurance in the amount of 22,990 and agrees, to the extent allowed by law, to hold harmless and defend the Lessor, DuPage County Four Association, their or cors and employees, DuPage County from any and all claims, losses, and expenses for injuries to persons or damage to property, including the use thereof, which may arise as a result of any act or omission which may result from the use of the premises as defined in the contract or caused by any person, firm, or corporation directly or indirectly employed by the party of the second part. It is agreed that the party of the condition of the party of the party of the second part. part shall furnish a certificate of insurance including this contractual agreement, prior to the event. Certificate must name DuPage County Fair Association, its members and employees, and DuPage County as Certificate Holder and Additional Insured. Certificate must include date of show, and set up and tear down dates
- 7. NO BEER or liquor is allowed on the fairgrounds. SMOKING not allowed in any barns or buildings.
- Parking must remain on a free parking basis. If a traffic problem in expected, the party of the second part must provid a uniform of officer
 to direct same. All fire lanes must be kept open by order of Gity of Wheaton Fire Protection Bureau.
- Special provisions: Admission to events must be collected after people have parked their vehicles. We surest at permanent ticket booths on west side of buildings.
 - 9a. Each trailer shall be charged \$45 per night for camping on grounds.
 - 9b. Club responsible for own clean up See #4 above.
 - 9d. Contract subject to Rules and Regulations above Please Read.

11. Both parties have read this contract and agree to live up to all provisions therein.

10. Additional Tables and Chairs, not provided with contract are available at \$10 per table; \$2 per chair. We will try to meet any other needs required, and those will be billed out as determined by use. Additional Electrical needs will be billed as required, as well as use of outside facilities, and equipment.
