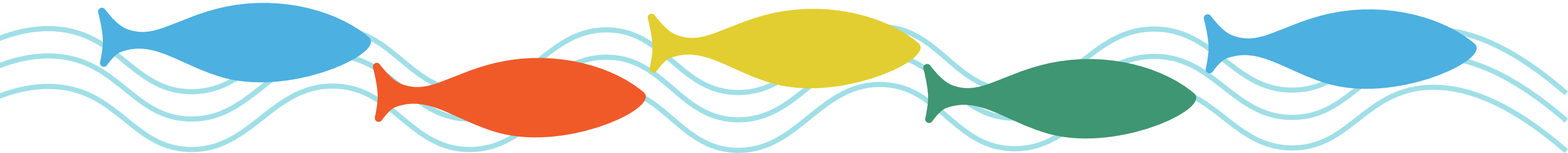


I am going to Fish-O-Rama at

Fish-O-Rama is a fishing tournament for kids and their families. If I am 15-years-old or younger, I can win an award for the most fish caught and largest fish caught.



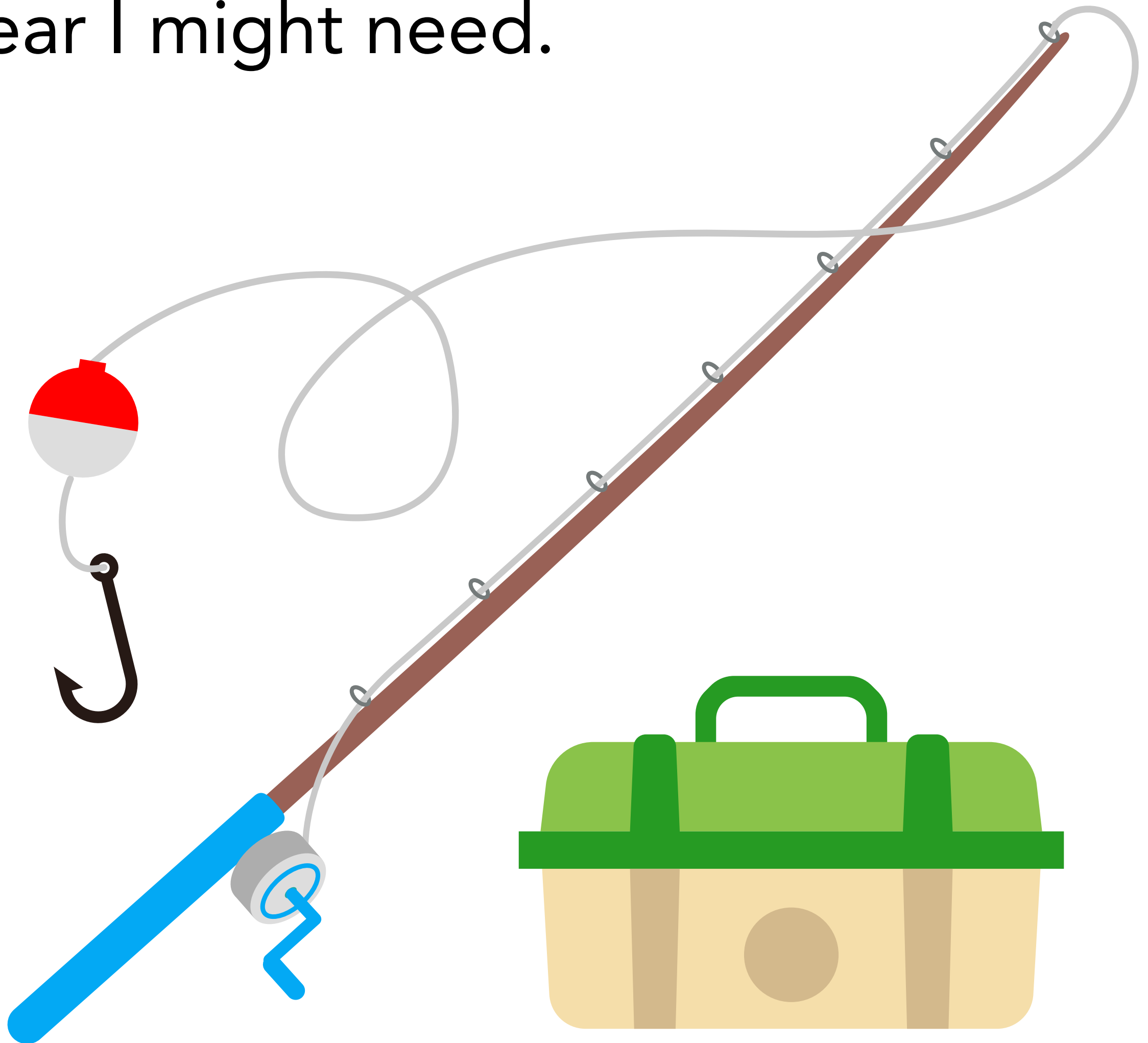
Northside Park is outside. I will need to wear clothes that protect me from the sun, bugs and weather.

I will find a spot to fish near the water's edge. I can pick a spot that works best for me!



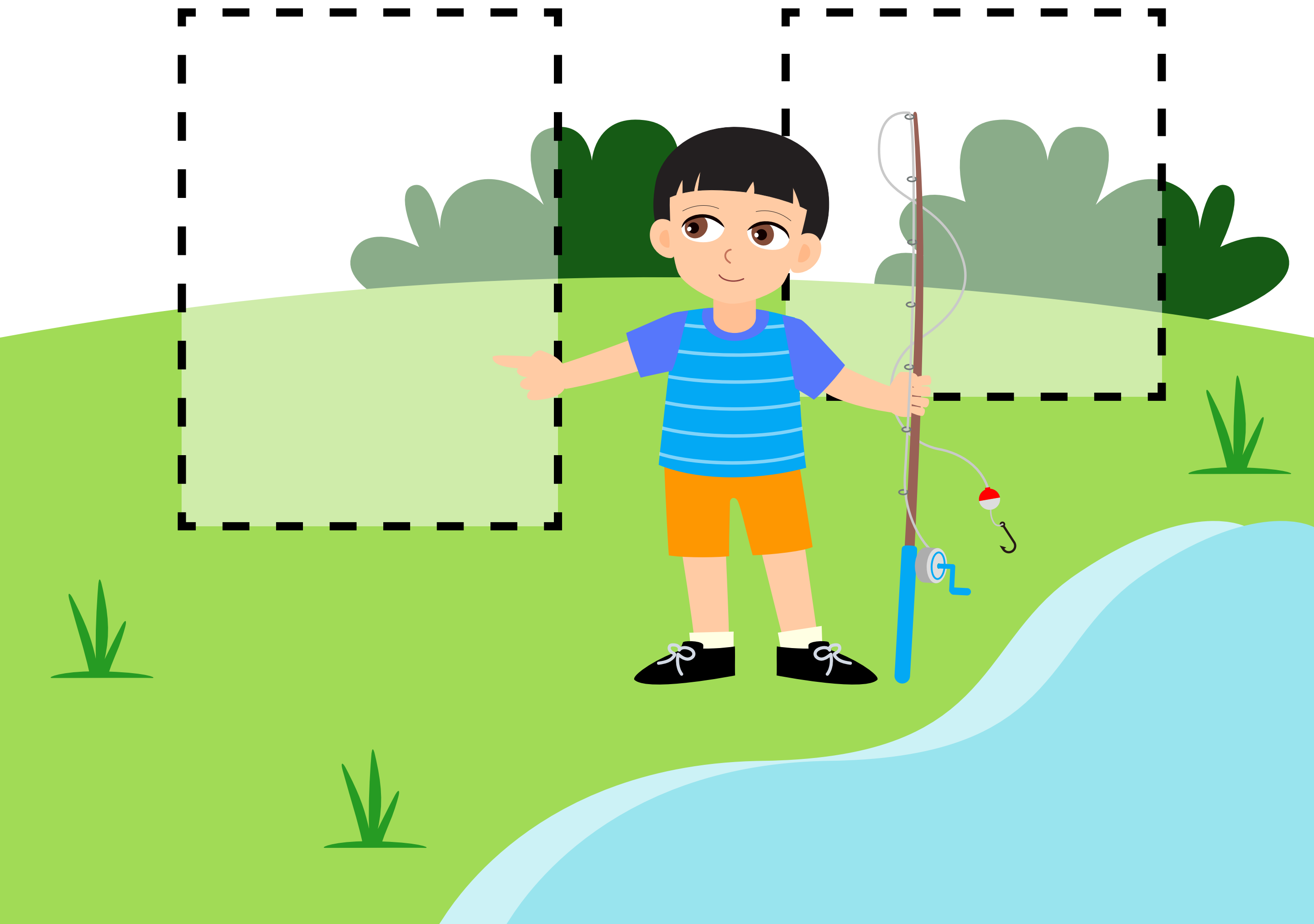
There will be grassy areas, rocks and wooden docks I can choose from.



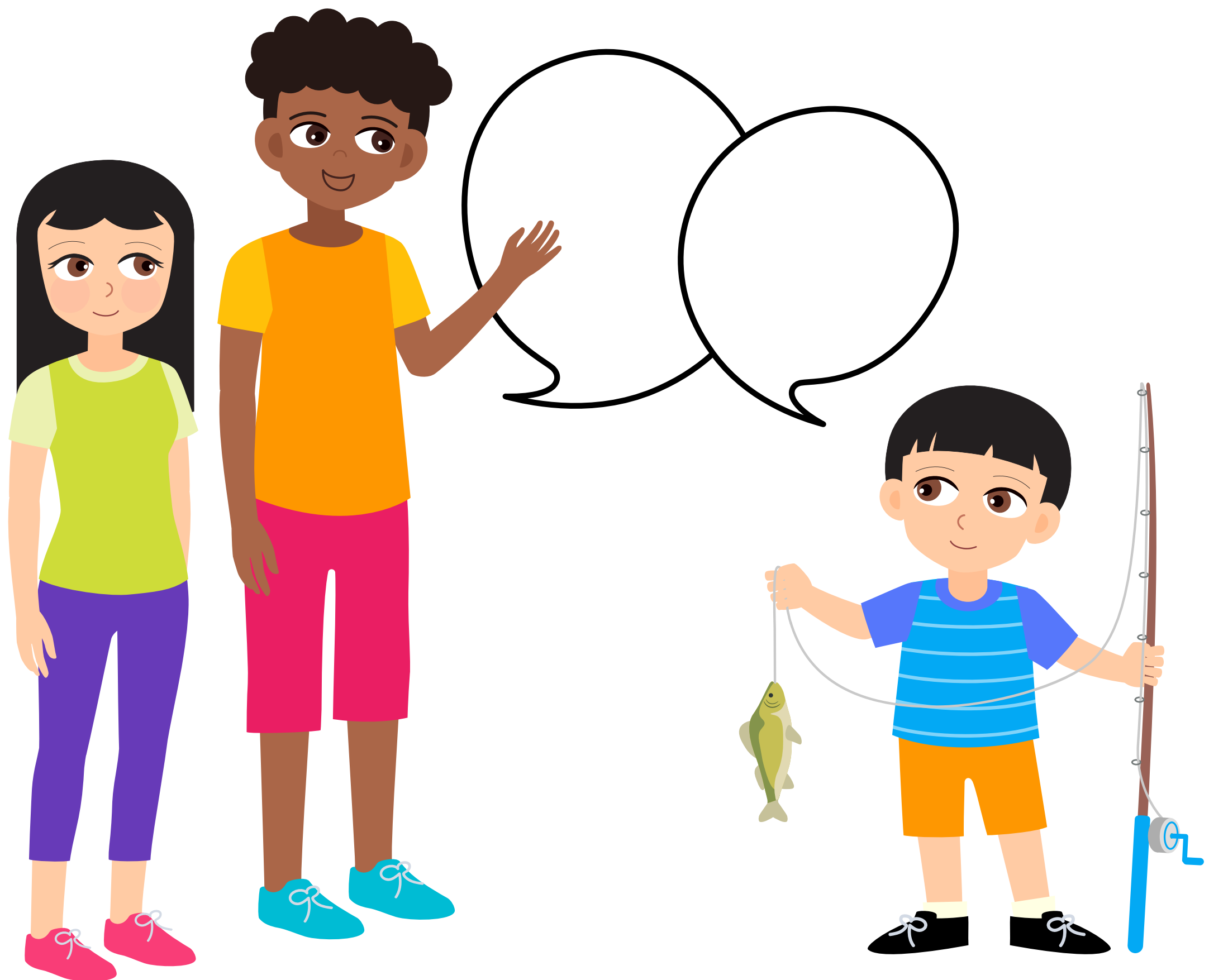
When I am near the water, I will

When I catch a fish it may be wet and slimey. If I do not want to touch it, I can ask my grown-up to help take the fish off my hook.



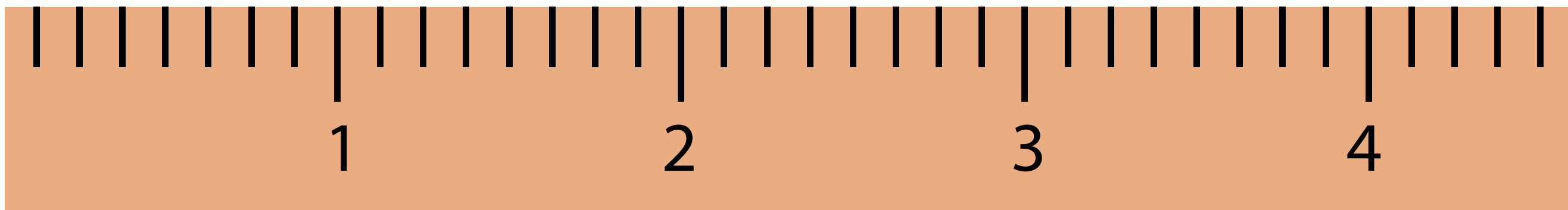
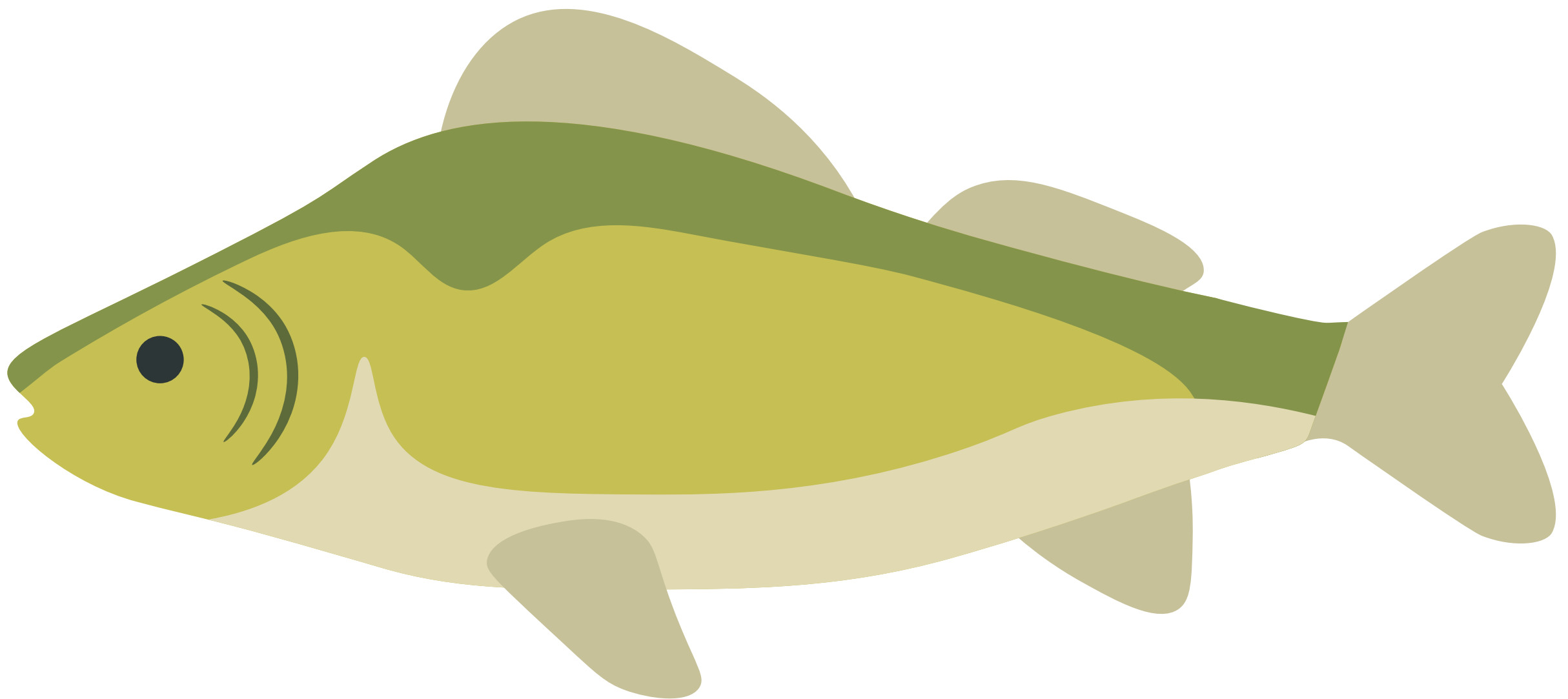
Once the fish is off my hook, I
