

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. When is Go Fly a Kite?

Go Fly a Kite is on Saturday, May 4 from 10A-2P at Graf Park (1701 Manchester Rd.).

2. What is Go Fly a Kite?

Go Fly a Kite is a free event encouraging the community to come out and enjoy spring in Wheaton and fly kites.

3. Where can I park?

Parking will be available for free in the north lot of the DuPage County Fairgrounds (2015 Manchester Rd.). Graf Park is easily accessible over the bridge. Handicap parking is available off Manchester Rd. by the playground.

4. Can I buy a kite onsite?

Yes, kites will be available for purchase from Gift of Wings. Guests can also bring their own kite.

5. What activities will be available?

The park will open at **10A** for concessions, vendor expo and kite sales. The grand launch will be at **11A**. The Chicago Fire Kite Team will demonstrate their skills at **11:30A** for participants. The Most Unique Kite Contest follows at **12:30P**. The Highest Flying Kite Contest and the Kids Candy Drop finish the day's organized activities at **1P**.

6. What if my kite gets stuck in a tree?

The Wheaton Park District Parks Department will be onsite assisting in rescuing kites. The Park District is not liable for damaged or lost kites. We strongly encourage flying your kite away from trees or other tall structures.

7. Is this event free?

Yes, Go Fly a Kite is free and all ages are welcome. However, concessions and kites will be extra. Additional fees vary.

8. Do I need to register?

No registration is required.

9. Will there be food?

Concessions presented by the Wheaton Rams Football program will be available for purchase.

10. Will the event still take place if it's raining?

This event takes place regardless of temperature but will not take place if rain is present or if it's rained significantly days prior to the event that would make the ground too saturated and unsuitable for flying kites.
