SUMMARY:

Staff requested proposals for civil engineering services related to site improvements at the Lincoln Marsh Natural Area. The scope includes:

- Converting the existing gravel parking lot to permeable pavers for environmental benefits and improving parking/circulation. Grant funding would be sought to help finance this.
- Removing and replacing an existing pedestrian bridge and improving drainage south of the parking area.
- Removing and replacing the existing ramps and landings that provide access between the Prairie Path and the Marsh due to their deteriorating condition. This was originally an Eagle Scout project. Different configurations would be explored as a part of this work.

The proposals were solicited on March 12, 2019 and the results are as follows:
