**CAUTION: USE THE SLED HILL AT YOUR OWN RISK!**

### Rules & Safety Guidelines

- Sledding is inherently hazardous and involves significant risk.
- The Wheaton Park District provides no supervision. Parents and guardians are responsible for child supervision.
- Snowboards and skis are **not permitted**.
- Do **not** build moguls, ramps, jumps, bumps, or hills.
- The sled hill may close due to insufficient snow or other safety concerns.
- Pets are strictly prohibited on the sled hill.

### Assumption of Risk

By sledding, you accept the inherent risks, which include (but are not limited to):

- Injuries from collisions or contact with other sledders
- Injuries from falls
