TERMS OF AGREEMENT

In the event either party wishes to terminate this Agreement, the party will be required to provide a 10-day notice in writing.

In the event either party breaches a material provision under this Agreement, the non-defaulting party may terminate this Agreement immediately.

This Agreement may be terminated at any time by mutual agreement of both Parties.

GRANTS AWARDED

The Client agrees that any grant funding awarded will be used strictly as outlined in the original grant application.

COMPENSATION

The Client agrees to pay the Contractor \$75.00 per hour for writing applications.

CONFIDENTIALITY

Confidential information refers to any data or information relating to the business of the Client and the Contractor.

The Contractor agrees to not disclose, divulge, or reveal any information obtained, except as authorized by the Client.

The Client agrees to not disclose, divulge, or reveal any information obtained, except as authorized by the Contractor.

CAPACITY / INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR


