WORKING AGREEMENT

between the Wheaton Park District and the Outreach Community Center

Introduction

Outreach Community Center and the Wheaton Park District have a history of successfully working together and collaborating with special projects and services to benefit the students and families served by both organizations. It is the desire of the Outreach Community Center to continue this successful working relationship to best meet the needs of the residents of Carol Stream.

In this collaborative partnership, our organizations perform the following respective roles:

OCC's Roles:

- Organize student volunteer teams to provide four or more landscaping / park beautification projects per summer.
- Obtain parent consent for student participation in any Wheaton Park District activity.
- Supervise student groups while on Wheaton Park District property.
- Educate students regarding Wheaton Park District program rules, regulations, and expectations.

Wheaton Park District Roles:

- Provide OCC student volunteer groups an orientation and instructions for their volunteer activities.
- Provide tools and supplies required for OCC student volunteer activities.
- Provide free or reduced cost access to the Park District's Teen Ropes Course to OCC participants after OCC students complete agreed-upon Park District volunteer projects.
- Provide free or reduced cost access to the Park District's water park to OCC student participants.

Collaboration '

The Wheaton Park District and OCC will work cooperatively to continue to make staff aware of the programs and services offered by both organizations.

Both the Wheaton Park District and OCC agree to work collaboratively on the items listed in the Working Agreement. This working agreement will be valid for one year from the date signed below. Both organizations understand that this agreement can be re-negotiated at any time to ensure that services to community are provided.
