

Kelly Park is one of the most popular of the neighborhood parks. Kelly Park is located at 1100

S. Main Street. This 17- acre park has a picnic shelter, a playground (for ages 5-12), and a tot lot (for ages 2-5). The maximum capacity is 25.



President's Park, located at the corner of Prospect and Dawes in Wheaton, offers baseball fields, a basketball court, a playground (for ages

5-12), and a tot lot (for ages 2-5). The maximum capacity is 50.



Rathje Park is a 6-acre park located at 616 Delles Road. Amenities include a baseball field, fishing, an ice skating rink, and a tot lot (for ages 2-5). The maximum capacity is 50.



Scottdale Park, located at 1855 Scottdale Court in Wheaton, offers baseball fields, soccer fields, picnic shelter, and a playground (for ages 5-12). The maximum capacity is 50.



Toohey Park is perfect for small children, offering Safety City, and a tot lot (for ages 2-5). The park is 7 acres and is located at 1900 Orchard Road. The maximum capacity is 25.



Triangle Park is located at 1100 Crescent in Wheaton. This park offers basketball courts and a tot lot (for ages 2-5). The maximum capacity is 25.

Permits

Park Permits – A permit is not guaranteed until payment is received and a signed rental waiver is on file. The permit is required to be kept onsite with the person renting the park shelter during the rental time. A security deposit is required for rentals.

Photo Permits – A permit is not guaranteed until payment is received and a signed rental waiver is on file. The permit is required to be kept onsite with the person renting the park area during the rental time. Suggested parks for photos include Hurley Gardens, Northside Park and Seven Gables Park.



FAQ's

- Are we allowed to serve alcohol at our event? Alcohol is not permitted in Wheaton Park District parks/facilities.
- Are bouncy houses or other apparatuses allowed? The Park District does not allow inflatables or other contracted equipment to be used in our parks.
- Can I decorate at my event? Yes, decorations are allowed. We ask that all decorations are removed at the end of the event. Please no stakes in the ground.
- **Do I need a permit?** Yes, any party over 15 requires a park rental permit. Photo permits are also required along with a certificate of insurance from the photographer.
- Can I rent an athletic field? Contact our Athletic department for availability and pricing: alewandowski@wheatonparks.org
- What is your cancellation policy? In the case of inclement weather on your event date you will have the opportunity to reschedule or receive a refund. We do not cancel due to forecasted weather.
- Can we have a food truck/caterer at our event? Yes, any outside vendor that will be on the park district property is required to provide a certificate of insurance. Food is only allowed to be served to those that are attending the event.
- What is needed to use the firepits at Northside Park?
- You must acquire a rental permit from the Park District.
- You must obtain a fire permit from the Wheaton Fire Department.
- Renter must provide their own firewood.
- Is there electric and water at the parks? No, there is no available electricity or running water.
- Does the Park District put out signs that the park is rented? No, at the time of rental you will receive a permit that can be posted stating that you have the picnic shelter/picnic area rented.
- How long is the park open? All parks open at dawn and close at dusk
- What area am I renting? Picnic shelters or Picnic areas. Playgrounds, athletic fields, and open spaces are to remain open to the public.
- Can I bring a grill of my own to use? Yes. However, if you are using a charcoal grill the coals will need to be disposed of off-site. Dumping coals or ashes in the parks is prohibited.







The Wheaton Park District offers a wide variety of picnic areas available for rent that are open from sunrise to dusk. Our parks and facilities are the perfect place to host your next event. All picnic rentals require payment in order to secure the park for any given day. The following picnic areas are available for rent...

Level I

Rental Fee-\$75/residents; \$150/nonresidents (per hour) in addition to a \$100 refundable security deposit fee Photos Only-\$30 per hour/residents; \$45 per hour/nonresidents



Hurley Gardens is one of Wheaton's most beautiful gardens. These European style gardens are host to many small wedding ceremonies and photo

opportunities. The Gardens are located at Creekside Drive, just west of Adare Drive. This small two-acre park has one tennis court. Maximum rental guest capacity is 50.

Level II

Rental Fee* - \$60 residents and \$120 nonresidents for 4 hour rental in addition to a \$100 refundable security deposit fee; \$25 for each additional hour

All Level II parks offer public restrooms and picnic shelters for your guests to enjoy. Playground and open spaces remain open to the public.



Atten Park is located at 1720 Wiesbrook Road. This 39-acre park has the following amenities: public restrooms, a picnic shelter, basketball courts, baseball fields, tennis courts, a

soccer field, a playground (for ages 5-12), and a tot lot (for ages 2-5). The maximum capacity is 50.



Briar Patch Park is a 26-acre park and is located between 1700 and 1750 Briarcliffe Boulevard and includes amenities such as public restrooms,

a picnic shelter, baseball fields, tennis courts, soccer fields, a playground (for ages 5-12), and a tot lot (for ages 2-5). The maximum capacity is 50.



Graf Park, located east of 1855 Manchester Road, is a 24-acre park. This park has the following facilities: public restrooms, a picnic shelter, baseball, softball,

football and soccer fields, a playground (for ages 5-12), and a tot lot (for ages 2-5). The maximum capacity is 50.



Northside Park is the largest of the Wheaton Parks at 68 acres and is located at 1300 N. West Street. This historic park includes such amenities

as public restrooms, a picnic shelter, basketball courts, a baseball field, tennis courts, soccer fields, an ice skating rink, a playground (for ages 5-12), and a tot lot (for ages 2-5). The maximum picnic shelter capacity is 100.

Girl Scout Cabin was built in the 1930's by the Works Progress Administration and is host to many summer camps. The maximum capacity is 25. The fire pit capacity is 50. Available for overnight rentals on weekends. Please contact the Park Services Center at 630.653.5429 or parkrentals@wheatonparks.org for rental prices and deposit fees.

Boy Scout Cabin was built in the 1930's by the Works Progress Administration and has been host to many Boy Scout activities over the past 80 years. The building capacity is 25. The maximum fire pit capacity is 25. Available for overnight rentals on weekends. Please contact the Park Services Center at 630.653.5429 or parkrentals@wheatonparks.org for rental prices and deposit fees.



Seven Gables Park is another of the Wheaton Park District's largest parks. This 66-acre park is located at 1750 Naperville Road. Seven Gables offers the following facilities: public

restrooms, a picnic shelter, a basketball court, baseball fields, tennis courts, soccer fields, an ice skating rink, a playground (for ages 5-12), and a tot lot (for ages 2-5). The maximum capacity is 50.

Level III Rental Fee* - \$40 residents and \$80 nonresidents for 4 hour rental in addition to a \$100 refundable security deposit fee; \$25 for each additional hour

Level III parks offer a wide variety of amenities. Each park offers a picnic area for your guests to enjoy. Playgrounds and open spaces remain open to the public.



Briar Knoll Park is located at 500 Tennyson Drive. This 6-acre park hosts a soccer field, a playground (for ages 5-12),

and a tot lot (for ages 2-5). The maximum capacity is 50.



Brighton Park is a 5-acre park that is located at 1297 Brighton Drive. This park has a soccer field, a playground (for ages 5-12),

and a tot lot (for ages 2-5). The maximum capacity is 50.



C.L. Herrick Park is located at Armbrust Drive and Herrick Drive in Wheaton. This park offers an ice skating rink, a playground (for ages

5-12), a tot lot (for ages 2-5), and fishing. The maximum capacity is 25.



Hoffman Park is an 8-acre park located at 411 N. Prospect. This park hosts a baseball field, a soccer field, a playground for ages 2-5). The

Hull Park is located at 1400 Hull Drive in Wheaton. This park features a baseball field, an ice skating rink, a playground (for ages
