RESOLUTION NO. 2015-03

RESCINDING TERMINATION OF PARTICIPATION IN PDRMA HEALTH AT THE END OF THE MEMBERSHIP TERM OF THE WHEATON PARK DISTRICT, BEING 12/31/15

WHEREAS, the Wheaton Park District is a member in the PDRMA Health Program; and

WHEREAS, in August of 2015, the Wheaton Park District Passed Resolution No. 2015-01 which called for termination of its participation in the PDRMA Health Program, in accordance with the PDRMA Agency Policies, at the end of its current Membership Term, which is December 31, 2015.

WHEREAS, Resolution 2015-01 included an option for the Wheaton Park District to Rescind its' decision by October 30, 2015 to give the Wheaton Park District time to seek competitive prices in the health insurance market and to give PDRMA time to provide firm quotes for the 2016 program year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WHEATON PARK DISTRICT BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

- 1. <u>Incorporation of Recitals</u>. All recitals set forth in the preamble above are hereby fully incorporated in this Resolution as if set forth in their entirety in this Section 1.
- 2. <u>Rescinding of Termination</u>. In accordance with section 5 of Resolution 2015-01 below, the Wheaton Park District exercises its option to rescind its decision to terminate its membership in PDRMA Health.
 - <u>R 2015-01 5.</u> Rescinding of Termination Option. The PDRMA board authorizes the Wheaton Park District to rescind this termination resolution up to October 30, 2015. The request to rescind must be completed by a resolution of the Park Board, and delivered to the Executive Director of PDRMA on or before October 30, 2015.
- 3 <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall take full effect immediately upon its passage. All prior ordinances, resolutions, motions, and orders of the Wheaton Park District Board of Park Commissioners in conflict herewith are, and the same are, hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- 4. <u>Severability</u>. If any portion of this Resolution shall be determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction in the State of Illinois, the remaining portions of this Resolution shall remain full force and affect.
