Specific Distribution of Trust Property to Beneficiary

DISTRIBUTION, RECEIPT AND REFUNDING AGREEMENT

To: Theodore M. Utchen 1996 Trust, dated April 12, 1996, as Restated January 9, 2018, The Northern Trust Company as Trustee

The Northern Trust Company ("Northern Trust") is the Trustee (the "Trustee") of the Theodore M. Utchen 1996 Trust, dated April 12, 1996, Restated January 9, 2018 (the "Trust"), which benefits the undersigned organization as a beneficiary of the Charitable Fund created thereunder. The Northern Trust Company is prepared to distribute, subject to this Distribution, Receipt and Refunding Agreement (the "Agreement"), to the undersigned organization the property described in Paragraph 8 of the Trust as benefiting the undersigned organization, which represents all property the undersigned organization is entitled to receive from the Trust under Paragraph 8 of the Trust.

Sequence of Events. The undersigned will sign and deliver this Agreement to Northern Trust, and then Northern Trust will distribute the Trust property to the undersigned; *provided, however*, that this Agreement shall not become effective until Northern Trust has in fact distributed such Trust property.

In consideration of the Northern Trust's distribution to the undersigned organization of the Trust property described above, and to induce the Northern Trust not to require a court proceeding in which a judge approves its accounts and grants it a discharge prior to making such distribution, the undersigned organization states as follows:

1. Refunding.

- a. The undersigned organization agrees to assume and pay all taxes and claims, debts and liabilities of whatever nature for which Northern Trust may hereafter be personally liable, to the extent that Northern Trust would have been entitled to be reimbursed or exonerated from the property listed on the attached Schedule had such property remained in the possession of Northern Trust.
- b. If is determined at a later date that a part or all of the distribution of the Trust property listed on the attached Schedule should have been paid to someone else rather than to the undersigned organization, or the amount of the distribution represents an overdistribution for whatever reason, the undersigned organization agrees to refund that property (including the earnings and appreciation on it) to Northern Trust within thirty (30) days of Northern Trust's demand.
- c. The undersigned organization agrees to reimburse Northern Trust for its expenses of recovery, including reasonable attorneys' fees, and any additional expenses of administration, which may arise out of or in connection with this Section 1.
- 2. <u>Receipt and Acknowledgement</u>. Effective as of the date upon which the undersigned organization receives the Trust property described above, the undersigned organization acknowledges that it has received its entire interest due under Paragraph 8 of the Trust.

This Agreement shall benefit not only Northern Trust, but also any other co-trustees, prior trustees or successor trustees at any time acting under the Trust, and shall be binding on the undersigned organization, its successor and assigns.
