All roofing work should be completed, including flashing, guttering, and exterior drainage.

The building must be permanently enclosed and weather-tight.

All block, brick, masonry, tile, marble and/or terrazzo work must be complete, cured and dried.

Concrete flatness and moisture content must meet the requirements detailed in MFMA Position Statements "Concrete Slab Moisture Content" and "Concrete Slab Flatness." and Humidity and Environmental Recommendations (see links below).

All interior painting must be completed and dry.

The permanent light, heating, electrical and ventilation systems must be operating.

All overhead work must be complete, and the floor area must be free of obstructions.

All backstops and sports accessory fixtures must be installed.

The materials are ordered and once the above is satisfied, I will release the materials for delivery. All materials are delivered together. While we install the subfloor, the maple will be acclimating. We are fortunate that the maple does not have to acclimate for two weeks in this part of the world. Typically it is less than a week. We will monitor the moisture content of the maple as well as the atmospheric conditions of the project (see above) and will install when both are in line with industry standards.

We need 2 weeks for the floor, plus 3 days of no activity and 7 days of limited activity while the finish cures. Limited activity means no covering of the floor, no rolling loads, no ladders or scaffolding and booty protected feet on all tradesmen.

The power requirement for our sanding equipment is 208 volt 3 phase 30 amp. We will provide 2 pigtails, but we will require an electrician to wire them into the box.

Any bleacher construction should be delayed as long as possible as the finish won't be fully cured for 30 days per the manufacturer. I understand this is rarely possible. I suggest waiting as long as you can, but no less than 2 weeks. Then the floor can be covered per our instructions.




