Work Order 15-01 consists of the following support for the Wheaton Park District:

- Meet with Wheaton Park District staff to understand current technology environment, to update the requirements for managed IT services and to develop the schedule for the bid events:
- > Provide an updated RFP for submission to potential vendors*;
- > Review all bids received (maximum of 8 bids);
- > Provide a summary evaluation of the bids based on the Wheaton Park District evaluation criteria and make recommendations regarding top 3 bidders; and
- > Support Wheaton Park District with vendor negotiation and the selection of a final vendor.

Note: *V96 intends to use the format and structure of the February 3, 2012 RFP (RFP ID: WPDMS) during this step of the process. We will update the entire RFP to reflect the current managed environment; thus, we anticipate updating key areas such as the current technology environment and inventory. We also plan to use historical annual managed service hourly information to update the estimated hours for performance on the specific managed work areas.

Estimated Cost Cap = All work will be completed on a T&M basis. Vision96 costs will not exceed 60 hours of support for this work order without the express written consent of Wheaton Park District.

Fee Structure: If Wheaton Park District signs a services agreement with a pre-approved technology provider during the bid process, V96 will defray or waive T&M fees associated with this project.
