SUMMARY:

The baseball board, athletics, district 200 and the parks department have been working together to renovate the T-ball field at Washington school to make it useable for more groups with the expanding baseball program. This requires removing existing grass, putting in a base limestone and top dressing with the red diamond mix.

Staff requested quotes for the purchase and delivery of red diamond mix, which is the material used for the surfacing of existing baseball fields in the district. The pricing received is as follows:
